Congratulations on your selection of the Heartland AG Systems Tender.

The Heartland AG Systems Tender has been designed to provide years of profitable and dependable service. To assure maximum performance of your Tender it is mandatory that you thoroughly study the operator's manual and follow its recommendations. Proper operation and maintenance are essential for safety and to maximize machine life.

It is the owner, manager, and/or operators' responsibility to:

Operate and maintain this tender in a safe manner and in accordance with all applicable local, state, and federal codes and or laws; and in compliance with labeling instructions by the supplier of the chemicals being used.

Make sure each and every operator has read this manual and thoroughly understands safe and correct operating procedure.

Make sure unauthorized people neither operate the Tender nor are in the vicinity of the Tender while it is in operation.

Make sure the Tender is maintained to preserve and/or improve safety, accuracy, and reliability of the system. Read and follow the maintenance schedule in this manual. Furthermore, as additional technology becomes available, the owner is responsible for improving the safety, accuracy, and reliability of the Tender.

Fulfill all warranty obligations so as not to void the warranties. The warranty information on the following pages outlines the warranty policy of Heartland AG Systems and its suppliers.

Heartland Ag Systems, dba Heartland Agriculture, LLC reserves the right to make product improvements to the equipment at any time. Heartland AG Systems shall not be obligated to make such changes to the machines already in service.

Warranty Policies and Terms

The Heartland Agriculture, LLC warranty is a limited warranty that is provided to the retail purchaser in return for consideration paid as part of the purchase price for a product. The selling dealer must review the warranty coverage with the retail purchaser and obtain a signature on the Operators Manual for warranty verification.

The warranty described here is for Heartland Agriculture, LLC doing business as Heartland AG Systems and its product line Heartland AG Systems Equipment sold and registered in the United States and Canada and normally operated in the United States and Canada.

Warranty Period

The warranty period for all coverage begins at the time that any person, dealer or agent first places the unit into service. At the latest, a unit is placed into service when purchased or delivered to a purchaser.

What's Covered

If a defect in material or workmanship is found in a unit and reported during the Warranty period, Heartland AG Systems will pay parts and labor costs to repair the defects if the services are performed by an authorized Heartland AG Systems dealer. If parts are needed during the repair, Heartland AG Systems will, at its option, use genuine Heartland AG Systems, or remanufactured parts.

Heartland AG Systems provides no warranty, express or implied, for a component or other item that is separately warranted to the purchaser by its manufacturer, such as tires. Check with your local dealer for these details.

Exclusive Remedy

The remedy of repairing a defect in material or workmanship at a Heartland AG Systems dealership under the terms of this warranty is the purchaser's exclusive remedy and is in lieu of any other remedy otherwise available.

No Modification or Extension of Warranty

The Heartland AG Systems Warranty is limited to the written terms in the warranty statement. Heartland AG Systems does not authorize any person, dealer, or agent to change or extend the terms of this warranty in any manner. Any assistance to the purchaser in the repair or operation of any Heartland AG Systems product outside the terms or limitations or exclusions of this warranty will not constitute a waiver of the terms, limitations or exclusions of this warranty, nor will such assistance extend or re-establish the warranty.

The warranty is void if the unit is used in an application for which it is not designed or the unit has been scrapped, salvaged, stolen, junked or totaled.

Limitations and Exclusions

The Heartland AG Systems warranty gives you specific legal rights and you may also have other rights, which vary from state to state. This section contains the entire Heartland AG Systems warranty. Heartland AG Systems makes no other representations or warranties, expressed or implied, and specifically excludes the implied warranties of merchantability and fitness for particular purpose. Heartland AG Systems will not be liable for incidental or consequential damages resulting from a breach of the written warranty or any implied warranty.

- These limitations and exclusions may not be allowed by some states or provinces and shall not apply to the extent such limitations or exclusions are not allowed by applicable state/provincial law.

Owner's Responsibility

The Heartland AG Systems Warranty remains in effect during the warranty period if the owner performs the required maintenance at the recommended intervals outlined in the product's operator's manual and the unit is operated within its rated capacity. Genuine Heartland AG Systems service parts or Heartland AG Systems approved service parts that meet Heartland AG Systems specifications must be used for maintenance and repairs.

What Is Not Covered

- Replacement of non-defective wear items expected to be replaced during the warranty period, including, but not limited to: lights, fuses, belts, drive sprockets and chains, hose, soil engaging tools, spray tips, fertilizer deflectors, spinner blades and accessories or items replaced due to customer demand.
- Normal maintenance parts and service, including, but not limited to lubrication, coolants, and filters.
- All travel costs associated with hauling or towing a customer's machine to and from a repair center related to any warranty repair unless specifically covered by a program or policy.
- Repairs arising from any unauthorized modification to the product.
- Repairs arising from service performed by agents not approved by Heartland AG Systems.
- Repairs arising from storage deterioration, failure to maintain the equipment, improper use of the equipment, collision or other accident, vandalism, or other casualty, or operation beyond the rated capacity or specifications.
- Repairs arising from abuse or neglect including, but not limited to operation without adequate lubricants or coolant, over-speeding, contaminated fluids, improper storage, starting, warm-up, or shutdown practices.
- Failure of the machine, its implements or attachments caused by improper field application or overloading.
- Premiums charged for over-time labor costs.
- Economic loss, including lost profits, crop loss, equipment rental or other expenses.
- Cost associated with cleaning of machine in preparation for service.
- Loss or damage during shipment.

- Cost of initial setup or installation of any optional equipment or attachments to a unit.
- Items used for repairs include, but are not limited to: solvents, cleaners, anti-seize lubricants, oil-dry, shop towels, shop supplies, special tools, etc.
- Included, but not limited to are checkups, adjustments, and shimming, tune-ups, spread pattern checks, etc.
- Unauthorized modification or field fixes.
- All costs of special tools or shop supplies incurred with repairs.
- Claims for stolen equipment or parts.
- Claims for replacing a complete assembly when the repair is less than the replacement.
- Claims involving the inspection or reconditioning of units.
- Shop comebacks: any duplicate, repeat, or comeback repair resulting from improper diagnosis, testing, or poor service work.
- Cost of removing or installing Non-Heartland AG Systems optional equipment or attachments.

Base Warranty Coverage

- Base Warranty is the factory warranty provided to the customer at no additional cost for a specific period covering the complete machine.

Tires

Tires installed on all Heartland AG Systems Equipment are warranted and serviced by their manufacturer's service outlets. Some manufacturers have separate service outlets for off road agricultural and construction equipment. Service is available by contacting the tire manufacturer's local representative.

Warranty Registration

All machinery items, which are invoiced by Heartland AG Systems on separate receivables, must be registered for warranty. The warranty period for all coverage begins at the time that any person, dealer, or agent first places the unit into service. New machine warranty coverage begins when the machine is registered. Registration is accomplished when a properly completed Warranty Registration is received and processed by Heartland AG Systems.

Operator's Manual/Warranty Receipt Verification

The Heartland AG Systems New Equipment Limited Warranty for Agricultural Equipment statement must be filled out and signed by the customer indicating receipt and an understanding of the operator's manual and the warranty statement,

- The original form must be mailed to the address on the form.
- Make one copy for the Dealer. This copy must be retained by your dealership the same as any other legal document.
- Make a second copy for the customer.

Heartland AG Systems Responsibility

If a defect in material or workmanship is found in a product during its warranty period, Heartland AG Systems will pay parts and labor costs to repair the defect when the service is performed by an authorized Heartland AG Systems dealer or agent. If parts are needed during the repair, Heartland AG Systems will, at its option, use genuine Heartland AG Systems new or remanufactured parts. These responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Costs for repairs that are the result of defects in material and workmanship
- Payment to dealers per policy in a timely manner
- Service information to dealers
- Identify product deficiencies and take corrective action by field campaigns
- Make determination of premature wear
- Provide unit that is free of defects in material & workmanship

Dealer Responsibility

Heartland AG Systems dealers are responsible for providing prompt, courteous, and willing service to all Heartland AG Systems equipment owners. These responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- Equipment set-up and pre-delivery
- Sell the right product for the intended application
- Inspect the unit and initiate recovery action on any shipping damage and or shortages
- Instruct customer on proper use, maintenance, and safety features of machine
- Advise and explain warranty coverage to customer
- Diagnose the problem, repair the unit, and submit claims in accordance with the terms and conditions of the warranty claim policies
- Take responsibility for saying "NO" to customers on non-warranty failures
- Apply failure analysis to questionable repairs
- Complete product update campaigns
- Have properly trained technicians and adequate tools for the job
- Retain proper documentation of failure repaired

Owners Responsibility

The Heartland AG Systems warranty remains in effect during the stated warranty period if the owner performs the required maintenance at the recommended times as outlined in the products operator's manual. Genuine Heartland AG Systems or Heartland AG Systems approved service parts must be used for maintenance. Additionally, the owner will pay for all transportation or travel expenses related to any warranty repair.

These responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Perform maintenance as indicated in the operator's manual
- Use the unit in the correct application (non-abusive)
- Notify dealer of failures and have the machine available for repair in a timely manner
- Training operators
- Travel cost, towing charges, and service calls
- Normal wear items
- Machine damage (accidental)
- Adjustments for application
- Machine inspection (daily walk-around)

Warranty Eligibility

The dealer is responsible to determine that any Heartland AG Systems equipment is covered by Heartland AG Systems warranty before performing a repair and that the repair is a warrantable failure. Any dealer who is in doubt of the equipment's warranty eligibility may call Heartland AG Systems for verification.

Warranty Repairs Made by the Customer

If a Heartland AG Systems dealer determines that the customer is capable, and the customer requests permission to perform select(warranty)repairs on his product, the Heartland AG Systems dealer is authorized to grant this customer request. The servicing dealer should provide the parts to the customer upon request, and to assure that customer is properly instructed on how to perform the repairs correctly.

The servicing dealer is responsible and accountable for claim accuracy and validity; specifically, in areas such as the parts replaced date, and assurances that the parts are installed as instructed by Heartland AG Systems. The comments section of the claim should clearly state that the customer installed the parts. The claim reimbursement will be for parts and applicable handling only. No labor is allowed! All replacement parts must be held for possible recall.

Parts Shortages on Whole-Goods

Dealers may submit a claim for parts shortages discovered during pre-delivery or during final assembly at the dealer's location. All claims for shortages must be submitted 5 days from the original ship date from the plant and before the warranty start date.

Warranty Reimbursement Policies

Heartland AG Systems provides for warranty reimbursement due to defects in material or workmanship only. Warranty does not include restoring any machine or portion thereof, which has accumulated hours of operation, to factory new condition. This includes customer owned and used equipment.

Except for only a few items not available through Heartland AG Systems, all Heartland AG Systems manufactured equipment warranty repairs must be performed using only Heartland AG Systems genuine new or remanufactured parts and accessories. Installation of non-Heartland AG Systems parts does not qualify for warranty reimbursement and can void the machine's warranty.

Parts

It is fully expected that all claims be filed using part numbers from the applicable Heartland AG Systems equipment parts book whenever such part number exists. Heartland AG Systems shall reimburse the dealer at the dealer net price (cost) in effect on the parts replaced date.

Labor

Heartland AG Systems shall reimburse the dealer at 80% of the dealer's posted retail shop labor rate. The retail shop labor rate shall be subject to verification by Heartland AG Systems from copies of actual dealer invoices to customers.

Outside Charges

Specialized repair such as that done by a machine shop will be accepted as part of a warranty claim at actual cost. Explain the parts used and the service work performed in the description section of the claim and retain a copy of the receipt. Retain a copy of the invoice with the shop work order to support the claim. Outside repairs that exceed the cost of the same repair, if performed by the dealer, will be reimbursed at a lower rate.

Freight

Heartland AG Systems will pay the freight charges when a warranty recalled part is to be returned to Heartland AG Systems.

Travel

Travel will only be reimbursed when authorized by a field campaign.

Repairing or Replacing Parts and Components

When performing a warranty repair, a complete part or component should not be replaced under warranty if the repair can be accomplished at a lower cost. If the total cost of the repair including the cost of parts, labor, and/or outside labor or materials is less than 75% of the cost of the parts, the part must be repaired.

Filters and Lubricants

Replacement of lubricants and filters do not qualify for warranty reimbursement unless damage caused by a defect in material or workmanship results in contamination or sudden loss of fluid. Lack of maintenance, operator misuse, or neglect will not qualify for warranty reimbursement.

Claim Form Guidelines

Claims Must Have

1. Product identification number (PIN) or serial number. All characters of the PIN must be used on the warranty claim.
 - Claims for parts warranty must use the word "PARTS" for the PIN. An invoice that shows date of sale or date of installation must be supplied for all parts claims.
2. Model Number
3. Date of failure – Claims must be submitted within 30 days or repair.
4. Date of repair
5. Warranty start date. Date the unit warranty starts or date the parts were sold for parts warranty.
6. Description of the problem. Describe all problems pertinent to the claim.

Comments should be as precise as possible, attach a separate sheet if necessary, to describe the problem.
7. Description of the work performed. List each significant action of the repair.
8. Itemize labor. Provide a breakdown of labor for each significant repair action in the "Describe Work Performed" column.
9. Shop order numbers. The shop order number field is used for recording your shop work order number that is related to the claim. The shop order number field can also be used to record the parts invoice number when claiming a parts warranty.
10. Customer information. Customer information includes the customer name, city, state, county, and postal code. It must match the warranty registration.
11. Warranty claim total. The total of all reimbursement costs requested.
12. Dealer signature and date. All claims must be signed and dated by the distributor to be validated.

Safety

Read and comply with the operators manual and safety instructions before operating the machine.

Understand that your safety and the safety of other persons is measured by how you service and operate this machine. Know the positions and operations of all controls before you try to operate. **Make sure you check all controls in a safe area before starting your work.**

Read this manual completely and all other manuals provided with this vehicle, plus make sure you understand the speed, brakes, steering, stability, and load characteristics of this machine before you start to operate.

The safety information given in this manual does not replace safety codes, insurance needs, federal, state, and local laws. Make sure your machine has the correct equipment required by local laws and regulations.

Heartland AG Systems is continuing to work for your safety by making tenders with better protection and by giving these rules for safe operation.

Personal Safety

Throughout this manual and on the machine's safety decals, you will find precautionary statements: **DANGER**, **WARNING**, or **CAUTION** followed by specific instructions or ISO two panel safety pictorial symbols. These precautions are intended for your personal safety.

Failure to follow **DANGER**, **WARNING**, or **CAUTION** instructions may result in serious bodily injury or death.

- **DANGER:** Indicates an immediate hazardous situation that, if not avoided, will result in death or serious injury. The color associated with Danger is **RED**
- **WARNING:** Indicates a potentially hazardous situation on which, if not avoided, will result in serious injury the color associated with Warning is **ORANGE**.
- **CAUTION:** Indicates a potentially hazardous situation which, if not avoided, may result in minor or moderate injury. It may also be used to alert against unsafe practices. The color associated with Caution is **YELLOW**.

Safety Rules

- DO NOT operate or service this machine unless you have read and understood the Operators Manual and have been properly trained in the machine's operation.
- Before starting the engine, be sure all operating controls are in neutral or park position. This will eliminate the accidental movement of the machine or startup of power driven equipment.
- This machine requires an operator at all times. NEVER leave the machine running and unattended.
- ALWAYS be sure the work area is clear of persons before operating the machine. NEVER allow anyone in the work area during machine operation. DO NOT allow inexperienced persons to operate this machine.
- Sound horn of tow vehicle before operating the machine.
- **NO RIDERS** – A frequent cause of personal injury or death is persons falling off and being run over. DO NOT permit others to ride.
- For road travel, use flashing warning lamps unless prohibited by law and keep SMV (Slow moving vehicle) visible.

- ALWAYS put the controls in neutral, shut the engine off, apply the parking brake, and remove the key BEFORE exiting the tow vehicle.
- Extra weight and bad traction conditions, such as mud or ice, increase your stopping distance. Remember, a loaded machine increases the distance needed to stop.
- DO NOT smoke while servicing the machine.
- DO NOT operate the machine while under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- Hydraulic oil or Diesel fuel are high pressured systems. Make sure all lines and fittings are tight and in good condition. These fluids, escaping under pressure, can have sufficient force to penetrate skin and cause serious injury. Failure can result in serious injury or death.
- Escaping hydraulic fluid under pressure can have sufficient force to penetrate skin, causing serious injury. NEVER check for leaks by using any part of your body to feel for escaping fluid.
- Before servicing the machine, make sure the machine has cooled down. Hydraulic components can get hot enough to cause serious injury.
- After servicing the machine, ALWAYS replace guards and shields. NEVER operate your machine with guards and shields removed.
- Be aware of all pinch point on machine and keep clear.
- Keep bolts tight at all times. Always replace worn or broken parts immediately after they are discovered. DO NOT use the vehicle if any parts are not functioning properly.
- Do not replace parts with other than genuine factory parts. Doing so could decrease the effectiveness of safety features or the accuracy of the machine.
- This machine is designed for the farming industry. Comply with your local and state laws governing weight, lighting, licensing, overhang, bumpers, maximum width, transportation of chemicals, and any other regulations that might apply.

Safety

- When disconnecting the battery terminals, remove the Negative (-) cable first, then remove the Positive (+). When connecting cables, connect the Positive (+) first, then connect the Negative (-).
- Disconnect the battery (both terminals) before welding on any parts of the machine. Failure to do so may cause damage to sensitive electrical components.
- BATTERY ACID CAUSE SEVERE BURNS. Batteries contain sulfuric acid. AVOID contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Antidote:
 - EXTERNAL – flush with water.
 - INTERNAL – drink large quantities of water or milk. Follow with milk of magnesia, beaten egg, or vegetable oil. Call physician immediately. EYES – flush with water for 15 minutes and get prompt medical attention.
- BATTERIES PRODUCE EXPLOSIVE GASES. Keep sparks, flames, and cigarettes away. Ventilate when charging or using in enclosed space. Always shield eyes when working near batteries. KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.
- When working around stage batteries, remember that all exposed metal parts are “live”. NEVER lay a metal object across the terminals because a spark, short circuit, explosion, or personal injury may result.

Electrical Line Safety

- Know the area before operating the machine. Be aware of power lines, electrical boxes, debris, and rocks.
- Watch for adequate overhead clearance when operating the machine.

Machine Operation and Roll-Over Safety

- DO NOT ride or allow other persons to ride on the machine. Riders can fall or can cause an accident
- DO NOT operate the machine while under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- Be alert and always know the location of all workers in your area. Keep all other persons completely away from your machine. Injury or death can result if you do not follow these instructions.

Noise Level Safety

- Exposure to high noise levels may cause hearing loss. Wearing suitable hearing protective devices protects against loud noise.

Hazardous Chemicals

- If you are exposed to, or come in contact with, hazardous chemicals you can be seriously injured. The fluids, lubricants, paints, adhesives, coolants, etc., used with your machine can be hazardous.
- Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS) provide information about the chemical substances within a product, safe handling procedures, first aid measures and procedures to be taken when the product is accidentally spilled or released. MSDS are available from your chemical dealer. It is the operator's responsibility to be familiar with the safe handling of the chemical used.
- Before you service your machine, check the MSDS for each fluid, lubricant, etc., used in this machine. This information indicates what the risks are and how to service the machine safely. Follow this information when servicing the machine.
- Before you service this machine and before you dispose of the old fluids and lubricants, always remember the environment. DO NOT put oil or fluids into the ground or into containers that can leak
- Check with your local environmental or recycling center, or your dealer for correct disposal information.
- Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) is protective gear worn by pesticide handlers as specified in the use directions on a pesticide label.

Maintenance Safety

- Before you service the machine, place a Do Not Operate tag on the machine.
- Always keep safety and information decals clean and visible. Replace decals that are damaged, lost, painted over, or cannot be read.
- When assembling, operating, or servicing the machine, wear protective clothing and personal safety devices that are necessary for the particular procedure. Some personal safety devices that may be necessary are protective shoes, face and/or eye protection, hard hat, heavy gloves, filter mask and hearing protection.

- DO NOT wear jewelry or loose fitting clothing, which may get caught in moving parts. Always wear close fitting clothing. Keep hands, feet, clothing, and hair away from moving parts.
- NEVER attempt to clear obstruction or objects from the machine while the engine is running.
- ALWAYS stop the engine and remove the key from the key switch when leaving the operators seat or the machine.
- When servicing the machine, always have the machine on a firm level surface. If shields or guards are removed or opened for service, always replace them before operating the machine. Never operate the machine with missing or open shields or guards.
- Keep the area used for servicing the machine clean and dry. Wet or oily floors are slippery. Wet spots can be dangerous when working with electrical equipment. Be sure all electrical outlets and tools are properly grounded.

Tire Inflation

- Consult your vehicles operator's manual for proper tire inflation.

First Aid Kit

It is recommended that you have a First Aid Kit on the job site and in your maintenance area.

Read Operators Manual

Decals which display the "Read Operators Manual" symbol are intended to direct the operator to the Operators Manual for further information regarding safety, maintenance, adjustments and/or procedures for specific areas of the machine.

When a decal displays symbol shown, refer to the appropriate page of the Operators Manual. Refer to the Detail Index at the end of this manual for locating specific items about your machine.

Fire Extinguisher

It is recommended that you have a fire extinguisher on your machine. A fire extinguisher is available from your dealer and can be installed on your machine.

This dry chemical fire extinguisher is approved for Class A, B, and C type fires. The operating temperature is -54° to 49°C (-65° to 120°C)

Hand Signals

It is recommended that all persons on the job site use hand signals for communication. Before you start, make sure all persons understand the signals that will be used.

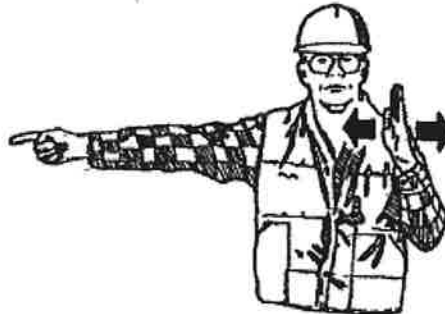

Your MT600 / MT900 tender is designed to be mounted on a chassis for over the road transportation of granular fertilizer and chemicals. Comply with all local, state, and federal codes, laws, and/or regulations Including, but not limited to:



-vehicle weight, height restrictions, bumper, brake, and light requirements.



Warning: Always wear proper personal protective equipment (PPE) when handling herbicides and other chemicals.



Caution: Fertilizer is very corrosive. Over time it will oxidize steel. This weakens steel parts and can cause possible safety hazards. Periodically check safety shields and structural members for corrosion. Replace or repair anything that could cause a potential safety hazard.

Operating Instructions

This chapter starts with a pre-operation checklist. Then it explains certain parts of the machine and how they operate. It also presents detailed instructions for the first time operators.

Pre-Operation Checklist



CAUTION: Read the Safety and Operating Instructions section of this manual before operating the MT600/MT900 Series Tender.

Inspect unit

- Be sure all shipping fasteners are removed
- Check tender thoroughly for screws, bolts, fittings, etc., which may have come loose during shipping.

Transporting

Before transporting the unit, make sure it is secured to the truck bed, trailer, etc. Be sure that the tarp and auger are properly secured in place. Make sure the auger is in the "Home" position before transporting. (*Home position – means that the auger is resting in its cradle*)

Operating the Tender

Hydraulic Drive-

The Hydraulic driven tender can be powered by any hydraulic power source, which can supply two sources of 25 GPM max. @ 3000 psi. When first installing, be sure the auger turns the proper direction, if backwards reverse the hoses.

- Truck Hydraulic
 - PTO Ratio needed 130-135%
 - PTO driven twin gear pump SAE B-4 Mount 1"-15T shaft (*Note: Pump will need extra support*)
- Engine Hydraulic

- Follow the manufacturer's recommendations in the maintenance manual.
- Maximum engine RPM will produce GPM needed
- Check to see the engine has proper oil level before starting
- Make sure oil tank valves are open

Unit-

Gates-

- CAUTION: Never load unit with gates open
- ALWAYS have the auger running before opening the hopper gate
- ALWAYS shut the gate and empty the auger before shutting the auger off.
- For some materials the gates are capable of allowing more opening than the auger may extract. Some materials may require feathering of the gate opening or slugging of the auger may occur. Operators must be aware and adjust gate accordingly.

Dump Doors-

- Pit dump doors
 - Are located under each compartment
 - Enables pit unloading without operating any of the augers
- Rear dump door
 - Standard on the MT900TA units
 - Standard on the MT600TA units
 - Located at the rear of the lower auger
 - Requires ONLY the lower auger to be turning
 - Certain types of materials may require feathering of the gates, to control the flow of product, and prevent slugging the auger.
 - To prevent slugging of the auger, the clean out door on the vertical auger may also be opened.
 - When hoppers are empty, also run Vertical Auger to empty all augers.

Transport-

- **ALWAYS** make sure the auger is in the "Home" position before transporting the tender.

Auger

- **ALWAYS** use CAUTION when lifting and rotating the augers, to make sure there are no obstructions in the way

- **ALWAYS** use CAUTION when approaching the built in rotational safety stops, to prevent damage to the machine.
- When raising and lowering the auger feather the hydraulic cylinder at the end of the stroke to prevent damage to auger, screw, or cradle.
- Lift the auger out of “Home” position
 - *(Home position mean that the auger is resting in the cradle.)*
- Rotate the auger to the correct position for unloading.
- Adjust the height of the auger for unloading
- Start the augers
 - Use Engine Throttle Control to set engine to run the Auger at the desired RPM
 - DO NOT run lower auger without discharge auger running, except for rear dumping
- Start the flow of material
 - Open the gate of the compartment to be unloaded halfway.
 - Adjust auger speed if necessary
 - Feather the gate open all the way
- Stopping Discharge
 - *(After unloading the desired amount of material, or the compartment is empty.)*
 - Close compartment gate
 - Turn off flow control valve
 - Return auger to “Home” position

AND SERVICE

Maintenance and Servicing

Daily Machine Maintenance

Overnight Storage

AVOID overnight storage of material in machine if possible.

Build-up of Material

Hosing the machine out with water after each day's use will eliminate build-up, if this is done before the material has hardened. The unit should be washed regularly. *(Note: Use 2" flush access located on the front end of lower unload auger.)*



CAUTION: All residue that is washed off the tender must be disposed of in accordance with local, state, and federal EPA regulations.

Tarp

Loosen the tarp or open Roll tarp, so any excess moisture can escape.

Check to ensure ratchet strap running between the endcaps is tight.

Fluids

Check diesel & engine oil levels

Weekly Machine Maintenance

Greasing

Grease all bearing fittings 1 shot every 75 hours, grease all supports 2 pumps every 75 hours, (see *Grease Bank Setup Sheet*). Use only a standard grease gun, **DO NOT USE AN AIR GUN.**



IMPORTANT: DO NOT over-grease. Over-greasing will break the seals on the bearings and allow fertilizer and dirt into the bearing; thereby, causing bearing failure.

Physical-

- Check tire pressure
- Check lug nuts

- Check tender mounting bolts
- Check lights, brake hoses, and fittings
- Check brake lining and adjustment
- Visual inspection for any missing/loose hardware, oil leaks, worn items, or damage

Between Season Maintenance

Hopper Body

Clean all the old fertilizer out of the unit and wash it down thoroughly. Clean, lubricate, and inspect guides for hopper gates.

Auger

Use washout port connection to wash out.



CAUTION: All residue that is washed off the tender must be disposed of in accordance with local, state, and federal EPA regulations.

Unit

- Remove the tarp or open and secure Roll tarp to prevent moisture from being trapped inside the hopper.
- If equipped with engine, remove the battery and store inside.
- If stored outside, cover the engine with a cover or tarp of some kind.

Wood Bearing / Hanger Bearing

Visually check part number RHB203631 Wood Bearing for wear before/after each season. This is a wear item that will need to be replaced periodically. See page 46A for detailed drawing. The Wood Bearing can be inspected by removing the plate cover (item 15). For Hanger Bearing replacement instructions, see pages 29-1 thru 29-3

Oil Filter and Oil

Change filter once a year

Change oil as required per oil manufacturer.

Physical

- Check axles/suspension components per decal on side of trailer
- Bleed brake air tank to prevent rust
- Check/Clean interior tank strainer on bottom of oil reservoir

Fluid Levels and Instructions

- Premix Anti-Freeze (*see engine owner's manual*)
- Motor Oil (*see engine owner's manual*)
- Hydraulic Oil (P/N: 4050) – 56 gallons
- Gear Lube EP85-140 (P/N: 1050) – 20 oz.

****IMPORTANT****

- Check all fluid levels BEFORE and AFTER each season
- Follow manufacturer maintenance schedule for engine if equipped.
- For Gear Box P/N: 1087194 (*item 10 on pages 53-54*), oil can be checked and filled using the gear lube plug located on the side of the gear box. If low, change or refill using EP85-140

Hanger Bearing Replacement

Tools Required:

Cordless Impact Driver or Drill

10" Socket Extension

9/16" Wrench

Punch

Anti-Seize

9/16" Socket

Flex Socket Adapter or Universal Socket Joint

Vise Grip or Pipe Wrench

Hammer

Wood 2" x 4" or equivalent approximately 4' Long

Note: Ensure power unit is shut down with key removed if applicable before starting maintenance.

Procedure:

1. Using a 9/16" wrench and socket remove two bolts, nuts, and washers securing the cover plate as shown in Figure 1 below and remove the cover plate.

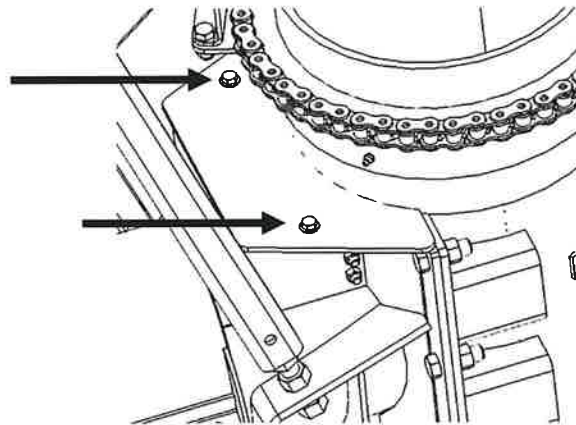

2. Using a 9/16" wrench and a 9/16" socket with 10" socket extension remove the bolts and nuts holding the top strap over the hanger bearing as shown in Figure 2 below. Remove the top strap and top half of the hanger bearing.

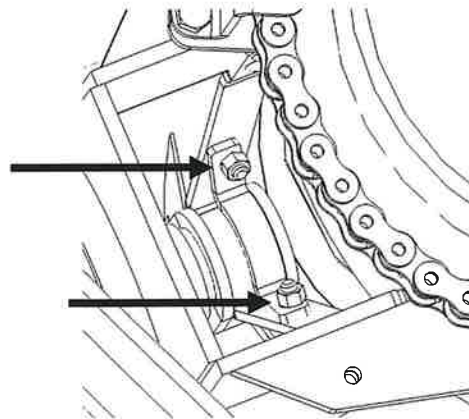

3. Open the bottom access/pit dump door as shown in Figure 3 Below and use a 2" x 4" to prop up the lower auger to relieve weight off of the hangar bearing. Wedge the 2" x 4" against the center pipe of the auger and the ground until the auger is lifted slightly.

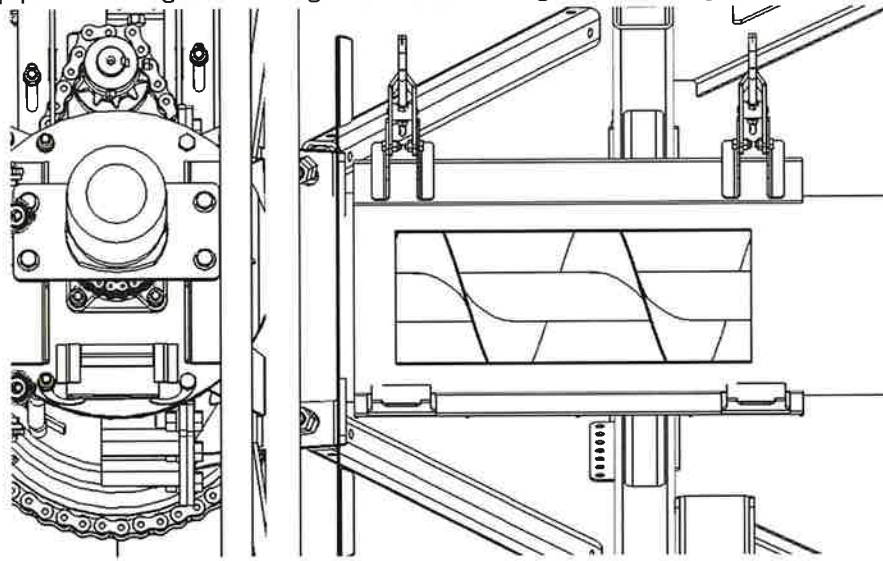

4. Using a 9/16" wrench or socket remove the 4 bolts and nuts shown in Figure 4 Below holding the hangar bearing in place. If the head of the bolt hits the vertical tube inside the access opening use the punch and hammer to drive the bolts out. This will allow the hangar bearing bracket to drop down.

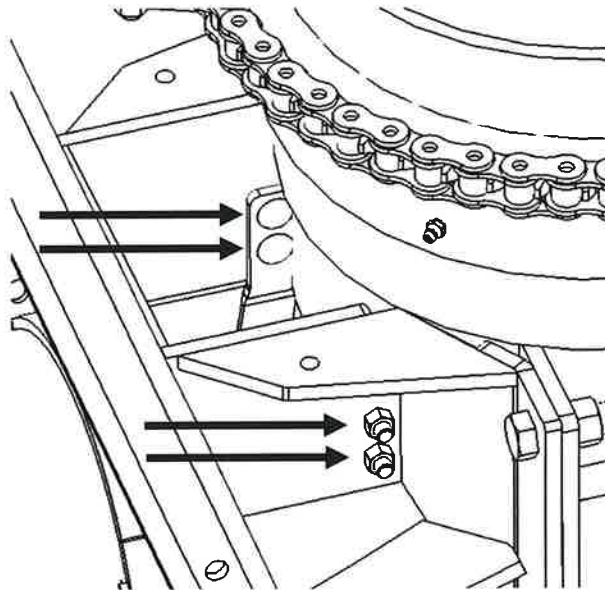

- 8.5 Drop the hanger bearing bracket down, rotate the bracket around the auger, and pull the bracket out of the tube as shown in Figure 5. Remove the bottom half of the hanger bearing and replace. If more space is needed to rotate the bracket around the auger use a vise grip or pipe wrench to rotate the auger flighting of the vertical auger and/or the bottom horizontal auger, the vertical auger flighting can be accessed from the back access door.

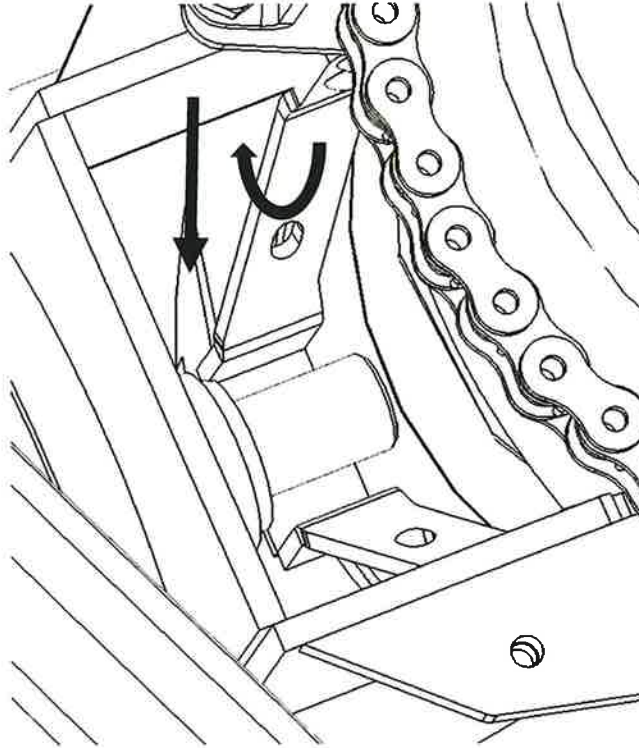


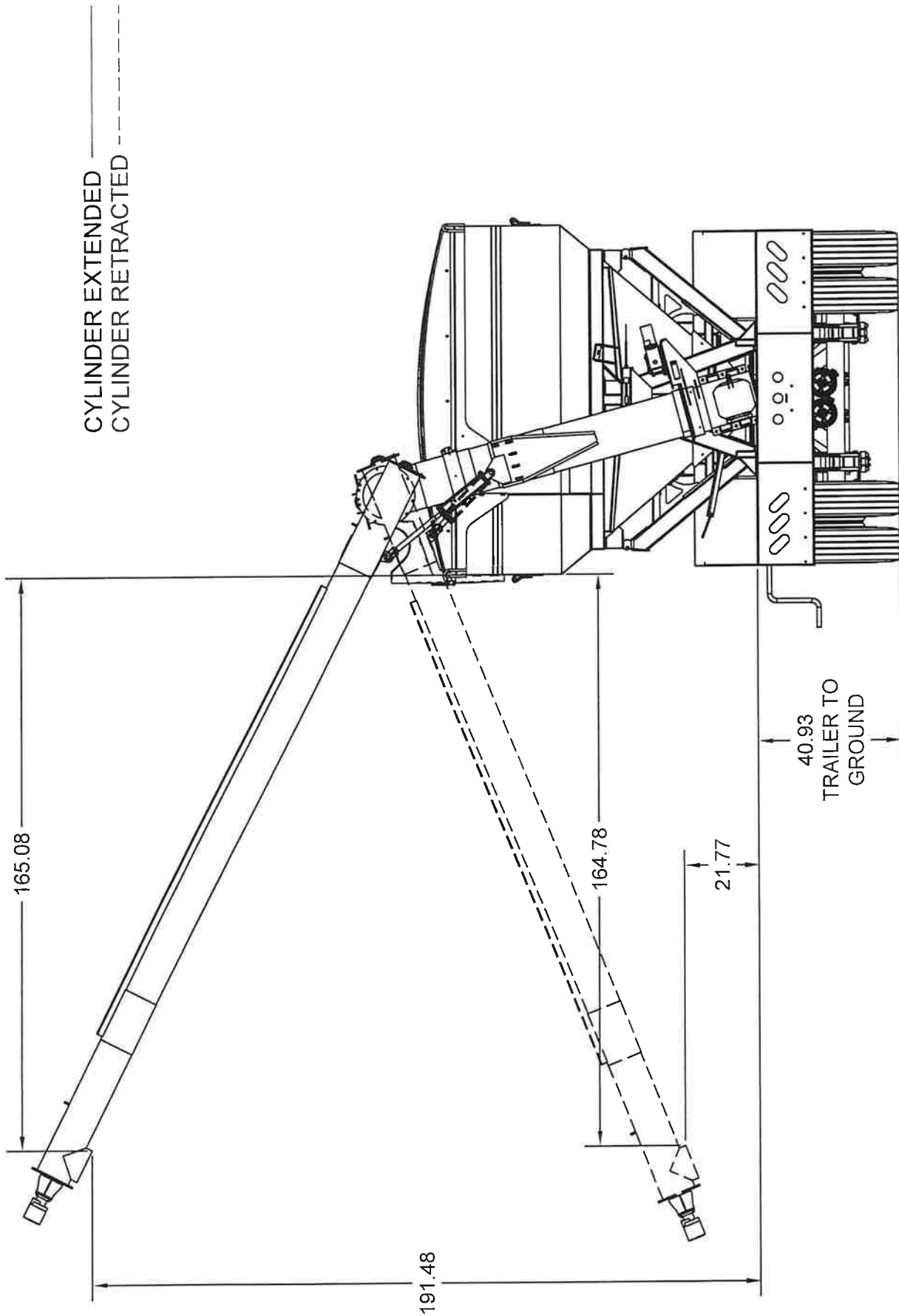

- 8.6 Reassemble the hanger bearing bracket back into place by following steps 8.1-8.5 in reverse order. Ensure the hanger bearing clears the auger flighting. Apply anti-seize to the bolts when reassembling in order to prevent the bolts from seizing in the future.

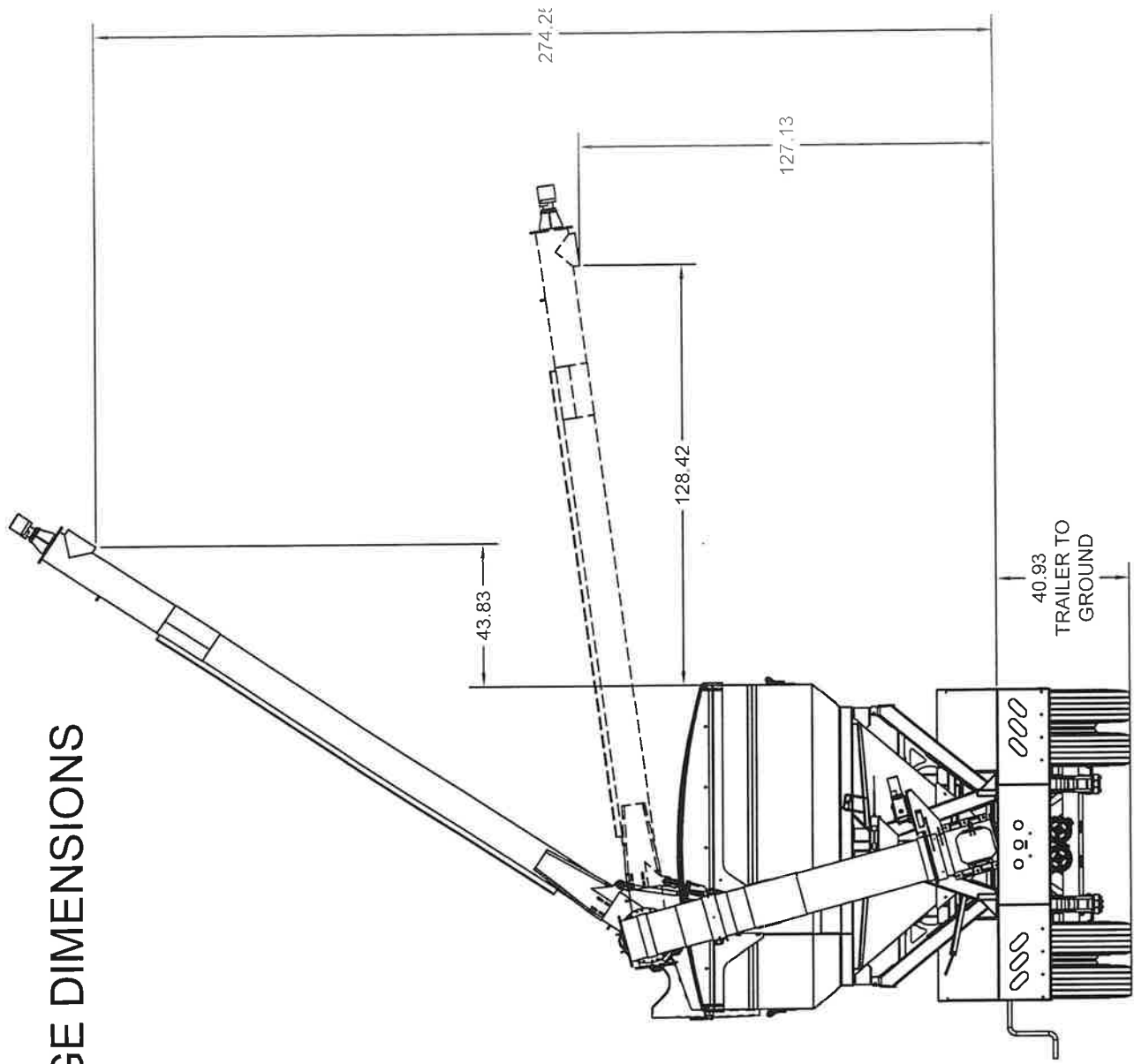

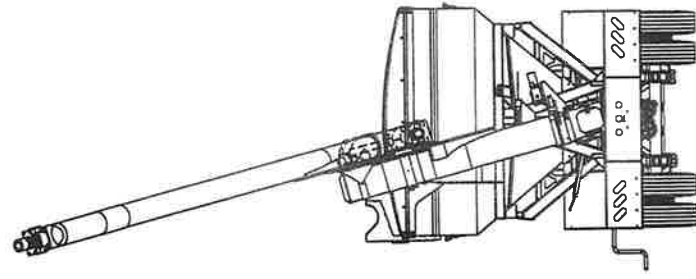


REAR DISCHARGE DIMENSIONS

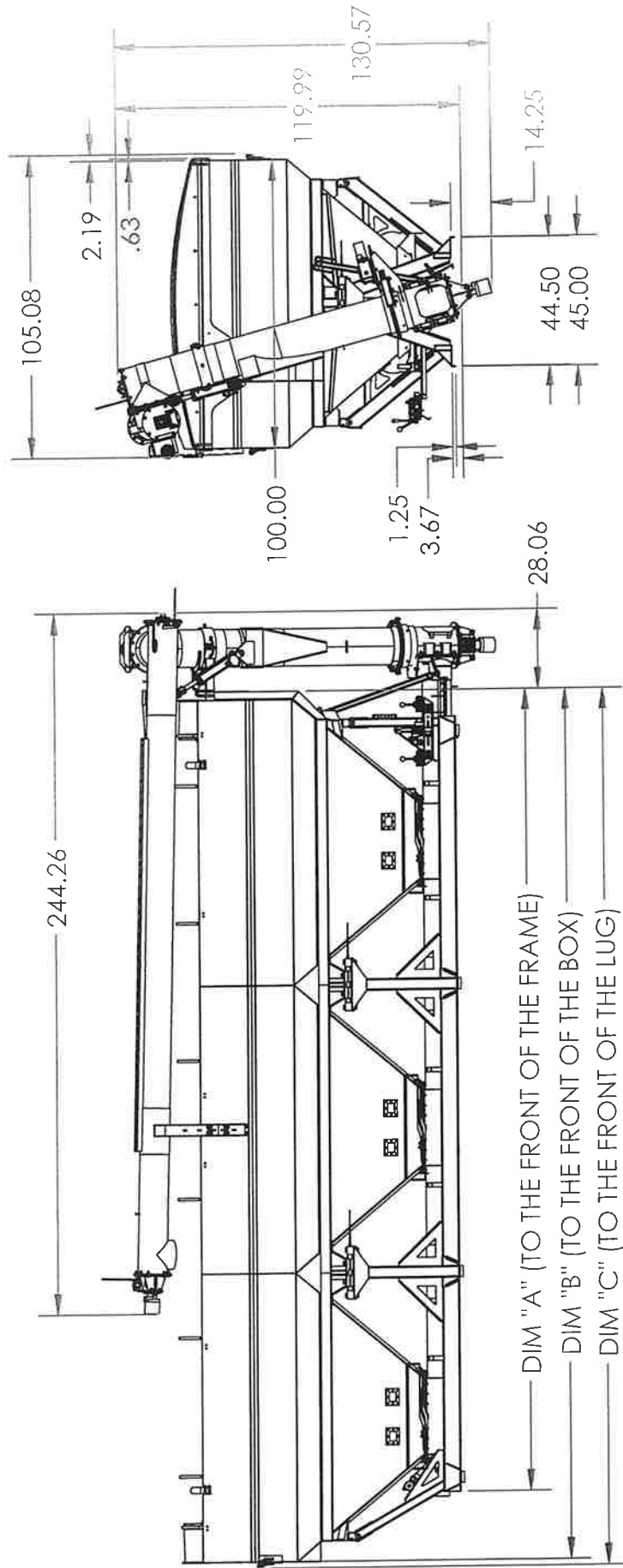

MT600 TRUCK MOUNT DECAL LOCATION



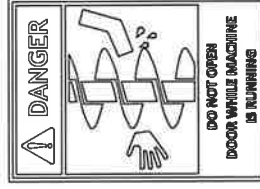

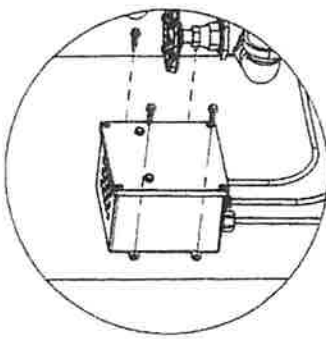
MT600TA AND MT900TA MOUNTING LOCATIONS
